### Homes for Ukraine - Free Bus Pass Terms & Conditions:

The scheme is run in partnership with Hampshire County Council, Stagecoach South, First Bus in Hampshire Dorset & Berkshire, Go South Coast and T/A Bluestar.

The scheme provides eligible persons with free unlimited travel on the buses provided by the company providing the card or smart code.

The pass or code will be valid for 12 consecutive weeks starting from the date the card or code is issued by the bus provider and is for use by the named individual under the terms of eligibility.

Free bus travel will be withdrawn if misused/used by anyone other than the person(s) eligible and may result in criminal proceedings.

If you were born in 1956 or before, you may be eligible for an older person's bus pass, or if you have a registered disability you may qualify for a disabled person's bus pass. Before applying for the free three-month bus pass, visit: <https://www.hants.gov.uk/buspass> to check your eligibility.
